

Great Assets of Our Faith – The Great Confusion – Matthew 9:35-38

Not that I have already reached the goal or am already fully mature, but I make every effort to take hold of it because I also have been taken hold of by Christ Jesus. (Philippians 3:12)

With this statement, Paul underlines the goal of Christian faith; attaining the resurrection of the physical body. Even though he was still in the flesh, struggling with the flesh, he was not overcome by the struggles of the flesh. He also states how he has overcome; he made every effort to take hold of what he has been taken hold of for. He made every effort to deepen his faith and live out the principles of his faith. Paul mentions this because he wants to encourage us to do the same thing. He shares his secret with us.

A deep faith is needed because our physical bodies will fail us. The pain of failure seems more than we can bear; and at times, it is. People without faith are stuck in their failures and their pain. People of faith have a better perspective. We know that all pain is temporary. We know that we don't belong to this world, but are citizens of a different realm. We have access to the King of Heaven, who is able to send support by His angels and His Holy Spirit. That access makes available peace and contentment in the midst of turmoil. I am able to endure because I am a part of a new order of things.

It is at times like this, allow these words to penetrate deep into your soul; ***“Then I heard a loud voice from the throne: Look! God’s dwelling is with humanity, and He will live with them. They will be His people, and God Himself will be with them and be their God. He will wipe away every tear from their eyes. Death will no longer exist; grief, crying, and pain will exist no longer, because the previous things have passed away.”***
