

“No one will ever know the full depth of his capacity for patience and humility as long as nothing bothers him.” -St. Francis of Assisi

These words speak the truth we find often repeated in scripture. Our struggles make us deeper and more profound people. God uses the experiences of our lives to mold and form us. People who follow Jesus know this well. Not that we love suffering, but we love God. Our affection for Him leads us to please Him and desire what He desires. What He desires is that we, “Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.”

This truth, indeed is familiar to all humans but many do not embrace the benefit of suffering. Many seek to shield their lives from all pain and suffering. This resistance of pain minimizes our inner strength, and the challenges that would otherwise strengthen us cause us to be weak and fearful. Worry and anxiety take the place of confidence and courage.

Growth and strength will only happen if there is a strong association between you and God. This will only happen if God is your partner in all aspects of your life. This will only happen if the partnership is supported by faithful prayer.

As you seek His will and ask Him to create His life in you, you will experience opportunities. In the film, *Evan Almighty*, Morgan Freeman plays a God character, (always interesting when Hollywood attempts to portray God) but in this case, the dialogue is good. Evan Baxter is told to build an Ark to save the animals who will be affected by a flood. Evan's wife doesn't understand. It sounds crazy. She is talking with Morgan Freeman, the God character. She asks him, “What do I do with that?” He says, “It sounds like an opportunity. (*puzzled look*) Let me ask you something; if someone prays for patience, you think God gives them patience? Or does he give them the opportunity to be patient? If he prayed for courage, does God give him courage, or does he give him opportunities to be courageous? If someone prayed for the family to be closer, do you think God zaps them with warm fuzzy feelings, or does he give them opportunities to love each other?” This is good stuff. It illustrates the combination of prayerful dependence and Divine Guidance. It underlines the verse that instructs us to, “pray without ceasing.” (1 Thess. 5:17)

Keep your eyes open for the opportunities to be deeper in faith...keep the lines of communication open so that wherever your journey takes you, you and God will be on the same page.
