## Sermon Summaries

Speaker: Ben Cook

AM: **Redemption and Freedom** - Galatians 4:22-26; 5:1  
God redeems His people. He started in the book of Exodus, and continues with this work today through Jesus. Although slavery is illegal worldwide, many are still slaves today. More subtle, though, are the surprising ways free people can still become enslaved. If that describes you: trapped in your life, and desperate for a change; Jesus can give you freedom and peace. Yes, you can begin anew in Christ.

PM: **Gideon the Abiezerite** - Judges 6:25-30  
Gideon has some very famous stories attributed to him. The Bible tells us that the first thing Gideon ever had to do, when he was called, but before any talk about a fleece, and before he led a handful of men to victory, he had to begin by defying his father, his father's clan (Abiezer), and cleanse the worship of Baal and Ashera.

In every way, this is relevant today. Of course we want God to rescue us from our sins, our mistakes, and our past. We long for an opportunity to start over. We deal very loosely with the idea of holiness (setting ourselves aside for God). We want God's salvation, but we still want to be who we will be.



### Tuesday Morning Bible Study... (Senior Saint's Bible Class)

Whether you are a Senior Saint or not, EVERYONE is welcome at our Tuesday Morning Bible Study which begins each week at 10:30 AM. We are just beginning a new study of the Proverbs - *God's Wisdom for Life* as written down by Solomon. With a class full of Seniors the comments can be inspiring. Come and join us if you can.

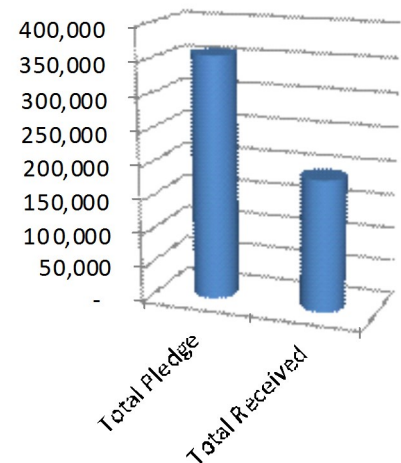
