

You know that person who finds something, and freaks out about it? The *it changed my life, and it can change your life, too!!?* Yeah, I'm that person with Financial Peace University because I've seen what it has done for me.

Yes, we got coaching about our finances and our financial strategy. We got coaching to curb our spending and to start saving. Beyond that, we learned how to sit down as a couple and put our financial dreams on paper. Who do we want to be? What do we want to do with our finances? We quickly decided that, unlike other preachers I knew, I wanted to retire, but I also wanted to give more. To the church. To the people around me who needed it. As we sat down and worked through the budget sheets week after week, we learned how to collaborate on our budget, and how to make our financial goals make sense.

Then something magical happened - we fought less. We had less anxiety about who blew the budget. There were less accusations about who threw us into overdraft and there was way less stress overall. After about a year we had more money. Money for our financial goals. Surprisingly, most of the stress in our marriage is gone because so much was tied into our money. It's the best marriage building seminar I've ever been to.

Will you benefit from FPU? Yes, absolutely. Old, young, single, married... there will be something for you. If you're not a member of FPU, you must sign up for membership in order to attend. It's a one-time purchase which you can do online. If you would like to purchase some of the memberships that Lakeview has, it will cost \$85, and please see me (Ben) to claim it. A membership is good for one household, and it doesn't expire. You, your kids, your spouse, etc... If you're not sure about doing a membership, drop in on our first class, then decide. We start Sunday, February 26th, from 1pm-2:30pm, and will continue to meet each week.
