




### AK: **The Power of Identity** – Ephesians 1:3-14

## 30 Day Challenge - New Testament

Now, the Super Bowl is over and we have the champions. The next championship is right around the corner, the NCAA College Basketball tournament. But, getting to the big dance itself is a riot! For the rest of February, college game watchers will be treated to all kinds of incredible basketball skill and theatrics, new heroes will rise, we witness good and bad time/personnel managements..., all in good effort to be counted amongst the last sixty-four teams to play in the tournament. In the end, the team that wins it all, often is not necessarily be the very best of the teams, or the most prepared, or well coached, or with the best set of players and tactics. Yes, all these can help towards the objective to win, but the history of the tournament has also proven that the less regarded teams that make the most of their half-chances, pay attention to minor details and rise beyond expectation, often get to have a say in who wins it all. That's how it's March madness!

Assuming that there is a game each day in March, and that the average NCAA game watcher spends on average an hour a day watching these games, that will be thirty-one hours by the end of March. Similar time investment on our part into the Bible Reading Challenge at one hour a day means we can read 8 – 10 chapters at five minutes per chapter on average. At this rate, we can read all 290+ New Testament chapters by the end of March.

To help make this possible, are several audio bibles that we can either just listen to, or listen to and follow the reading with the scriptures opened. Some of these have apps that can be installed on our mobile phones and can be listened to passively or actively while we multitask. I've listed some of the free ones below:


