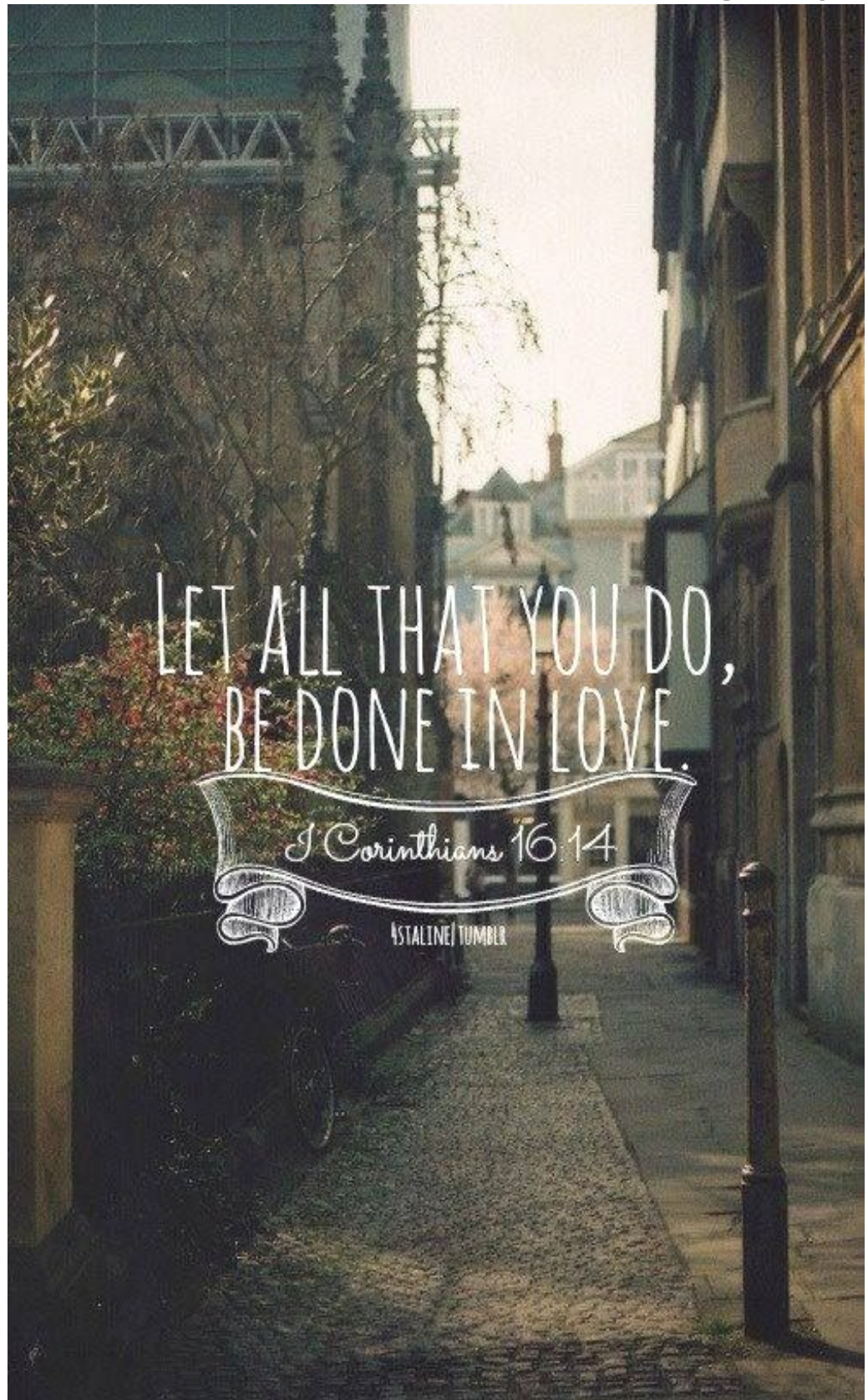

Sermon Summaries

AM Speaker: Ben Cook

Wisdom and Stature Luke 2:41-46; 51-52

Becoming a mom or a dad is easy. Being a father or a mother is a lot harder, for many reasons. One of the greatest challenges for parents today is the outsourcing of parenthood. Schools. Sports. Church programs. It happens so frequently that we rarely acknowledge how much of a responsibility our children are; and not just "providing food and shelter." Kids develop their intellect, faith, character, vocation, relationships. Luke says of Jesus that he "increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor of God and man." (Lk 2:52). Through all that, parents guard, guide, and direct. It's a big job.

Spring Bible Classes

Our Bible classes are really learning communities. These are times to learn and grow together, not only in God's Word but also in our relationships with one another. Some may wonder about the importance of Bible classes. While there are several reasons to be connected to a learning community, a significant one is to balance the false philosophies of media and culture. While the time spent under media and culture often outweighs our time spent in Bible study, it is important to gain every advantage and learn the things that please God and benefit our lives.

Sunday AM

Auditorium - Restoration History – This class focuses on the heritage of the Churches of Christ in the historical stream of church history. It will answer questions like, "why do we worship the way we do?" and, "why is the church of Christ different from other churches?" It will include a brief sketch of the events leading up to the Restoration Movement and present how that movement shaped the Churches of Christ today. The teacher is Dennis Baker

Room # 4 – Love and Respect – Recent research reveals that love best motivates a woman and respect most powerfully motivates a man. Couples report that during marital conflict, a husband most often reacts unlovingly when feeling disrespected, and a wife reacts disrespectfully when feeling unloved. In this class, you will learn the principles that help you impart these great gifts of Love and Respect to your spouse. Ben Cook will be teaching the class.

Auditorium – Wild At Heart – This is a class for men, designed to help men discover "the secret of a man's soul." Don Mellor and Dennis Baker will co-teach this class

Room # 4 – Everything You Need – This class is for women, and it will focus on the ways women feel overwhelmed by the demands of work or family, or the demand of balancing work AND family. Katie Towell and Lindsay York will co-teach this class.
