AM Speaker: Don Mellor


It is Time to Remember - Psalms 78:1-8

It seems like our calendars are filled with dates to remember: birthdays, anniversaries, and holidays. Yet, there are some days we do not seem to remember or celebrate. Yesterday was Armed Forces Day, May 29th will be Memorial Day, and July 4th is Independence Day. To most of us, celebrating those days means having a family picnic or a camping trip. Why should I remember the meaning behind days like that? God has given us days and instruction that He wants us to remember. Today, we will look at why remembering is important to the Christian walk.

The Birth of Samson - Judges 13

The more I study about the life of Samson, the more I'm convinced that Samson gets thrown under the bus in our Bible classes. His calling as a Nazarite - for life - was important in how God was able to use him to liberate Israel. Come back tonight, and we will geek out on the nuances of the Nazarite vow together.



This statement is not originally mine, but it does resonate in my heart. Someone said, "I am thankful for the members and leaders of the Lakeview church of Christ a generation ago. By their faith and vision, we have a comfortable place to worship and carry on the tasks of ministry." Because of this place, countless lives have been impacted for eternity. Sometimes we can lose track of that in our criticisms of past generations. Yet, in our evaluation of the legacy of the past generation, we seek to establish a positive legacy of our own. That means that every generation must do its part, if the legacy is to endure.

We are at a point in the history of Lakeview, when the current generation of members and leaders are called to act in a way that will positively affect the generations to come. As a group, we have decided to add to our building to create spaces that we can use to teach the good news of Jesus. These spaces include classrooms for children and adults, a large multi-purpose room for fellowship and other special functions and a foyer area to create a space for welcoming our guests.

Funding has always been a concern. At this point we have close to half of what we need already in the bank. To close the funding gap, the elders have chosen to issue bonds that will generate the cashflow that we need. This is something that all members at Lakeview can participate in, as the bonds become long-term investments. This funding approach offers many benefits to members and friends of members. These benefits will be explained during a bond purchasing weekend that will be scheduled for the near future.

To facilitate this bond purchase weekend, Lakeview needs to form four essential task forces. These are:

- * **Appointments Task Force** – Schedules Appointments with Members to Arrange Purchase of Bonds.
- * **Hospitality Task Force** - Provides Food/Snacks for Great Nation Representatives.
- * **Publicity Task Force** - Creatively Gets the Word Out to Lakeview Members, Friends and Associates About Our Bond Issue.
- * **Special Purchase Task Force** - Arranges Meetings and Presentations for Special Purchase Situations in which investors make larger purchases. The Investors are members, family and friends.

Please talk to me (Dennis) if you have questions about the functions of these task forces or would like to head up a task force. This is an important step in our building journey. The involvement of everyone will help us reach our destination.
