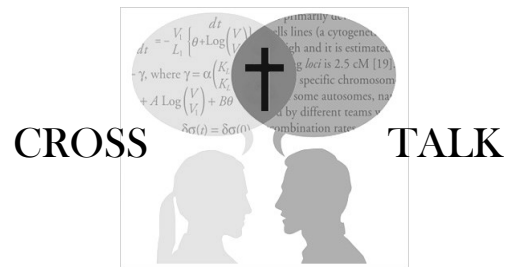
PM: Hopefully It Won't Take A Large Fish – Jonah 3:1-4

We will continue to do as God has directed us, by feeding the hungry, giving clothes to those in need, and most of all, we always plant a seed of encouragement in every bag.

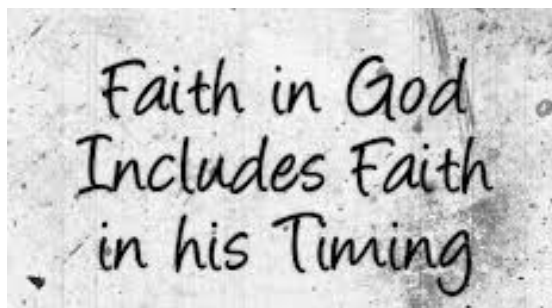
