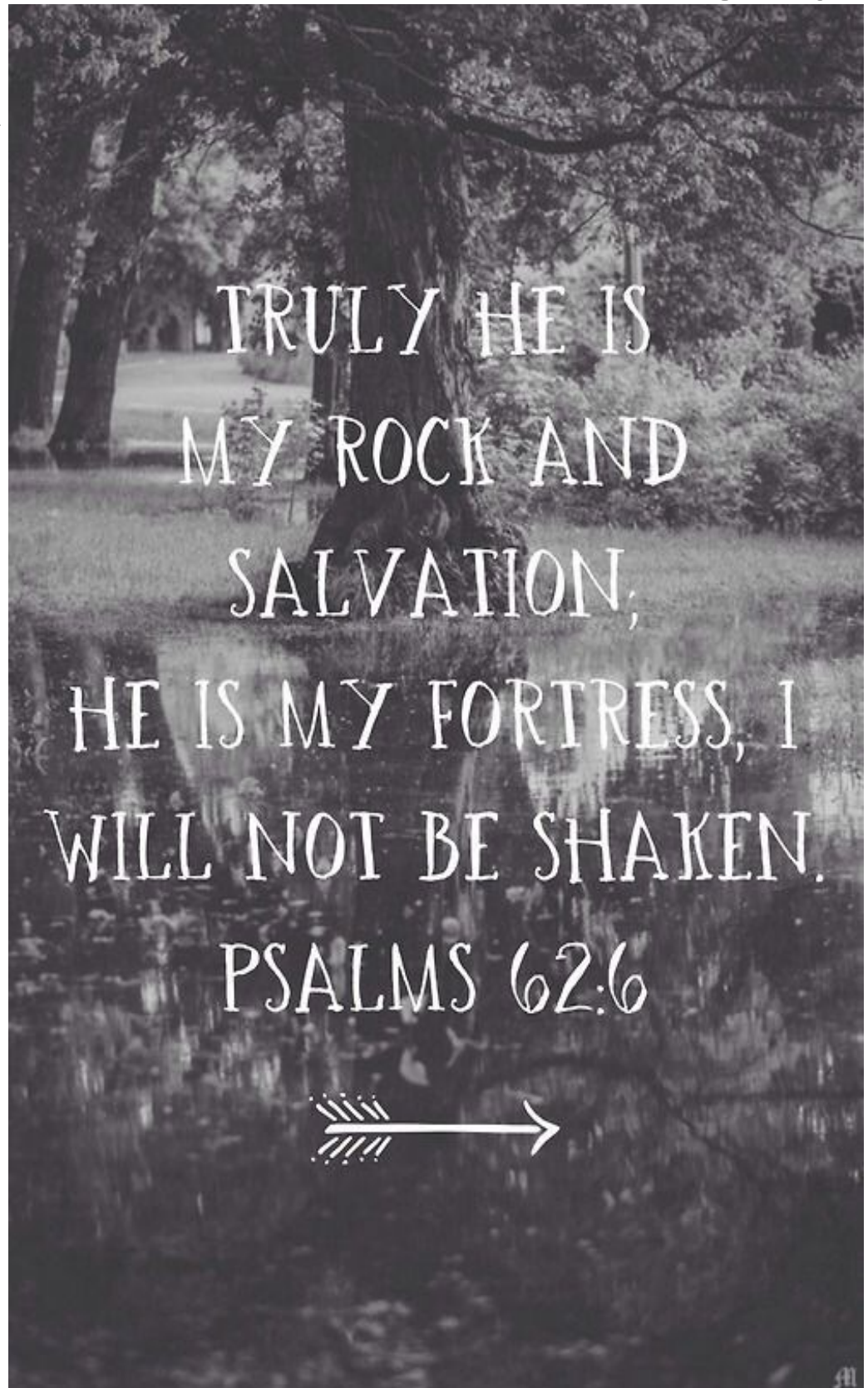

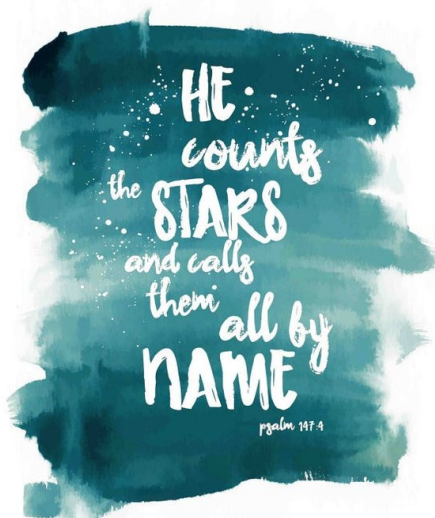
Speaker: Dennis Baker

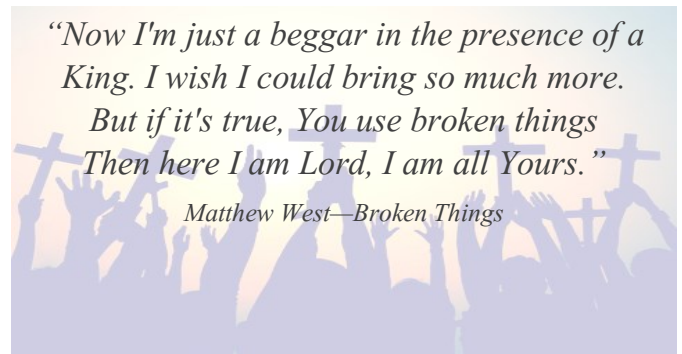
