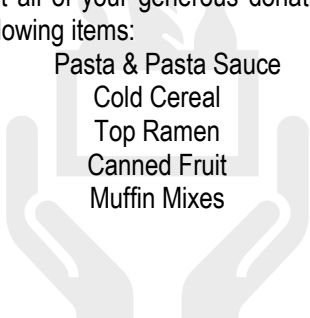
Please pray for them as they travel to Arkansas. This is their last Sunday with us.
