

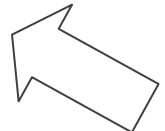
## Food & Clothing Bank...
