

Rarely do we get the opportunity to see first-hand the danger of progressive legislation that panders to the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes and the pride of life.

I am speaking about a law that went into effect on the day after Christmas of 2015 (163-32 WAC). This law gives preference to those who see themselves as transgendered and allows those individuals to choose the bathroom, dressing room and locker room that is consistent with their gender identity or gender expression. It makes it a crime to report the presence of an anatomically designated male in a designated female bathroom, locker room or shower. The law instructs employers and businesses how to deal with people who are uncomfortable with men in a woman's bathroom, locker room, or shower; "the person expressing discomfort should be directed to a separate or gender-neutral facility." Expressing discomfort is seen as a form of harassment.

While the law is intended to prevent discrimination towards people who consider themselves as transgendered, it creates an 'at risk' situation for other vulnerable people. This law, which basically allows a male to be in a female designated bathroom, locker room or shower, puts women and children at risk for being exposed to males, voyeurism, sexual misconduct and sexual molestation. In Canada, where such progressive laws have been enacted, all of the above risks have in fact happened. Several of these violations of privacy and sexual misconduct have taken place in the United States.

A "Safe Spaces for Women and Children" Rally will take place at the State Capitol in Olympia, on the North Steps of the Legislative Building on Monday, February 15 from 9:00 AM to 10:45 AM. It is imperative that Christians find positive ways to protect the most vulnerable of society. Attending this rally will send a message to the Legislature and the Governor, that the people of Washington care about the safety of everyone.




