

I had the opportunity to view one of the most important votes of the 2016 Legislative session. The Washington State Senate voted to keep in force the rules created by WAC 162-32-060. It was a sobering experience because I could see first-hand the peril of people without a solid moral foundation, making decisions that affect everyone. In this case, Seattle progressives led the fight and made it a LGBTQ issue. The result is women and children will be at risk in public showers, locker/changing rooms and bathrooms.

The vote was primarily along party lines and I don't have to tell you which political party voted to keep the rules created by a biased agenda-driven committee in force. Not only can any man walk into a women's place of privacy, if my wife says anything about it to the facility manager, she becomes a law-breaker. Women and children who are survivors of sexual assault had no voice in the Senate. Women and children who will be victims of sexual assault in the future were given no protection. The laws intended to address the issue don't have any power until after the crime is committed.

Before I went to the Capitol, I was at Daniel's House of prayer, located near the Capitol grounds. One of the leaders made this statement: *"We are in a spiritual battle and Satan is actively involved in this issue! Satan knows better than any of us what is at stake in the area of sexual deviancy. He has come to "kill, steal, and destroy". Distorting God's design for sex and preying on children are some of his favorite weapons." He will not give up ground easily. Please be praying fervently, as this is an area that he will fight to maintain. Pray for those in the midst of the battle. As you know, Satan does not play fair. It will take the prayers of God's people to heal our land."* This reminds us of the most important action that members of the Lord's Church can take.

In addition, we need to contact our Senators and Representatives. There is one more bill before the Senate that needs to be supported. It is SB-6548. (There is also a companion bill in the House of Reps.) It keeps men and women in their gender-designated bathrooms, showers and locker/changing rooms.

We can also attend the *Safe Spaces For Women & Children Rally*, Monday, Feb. 15th from 9:00-10:45am. The rally will occur on the Olympia Capitol building North Legislative steps. There will also be a LGBTQ counter rally in the area. This should be an exciting event.

Parking is an important consideration. Getting there early is a must. You can use the DASH shuttle. It runs every 15 minutes. I have parking information and information regarding the WAC rules and how you can influence your Legislator.




- \* Marlene Granberg is requesting prayers for Sam, who fell and fractured his hip.
