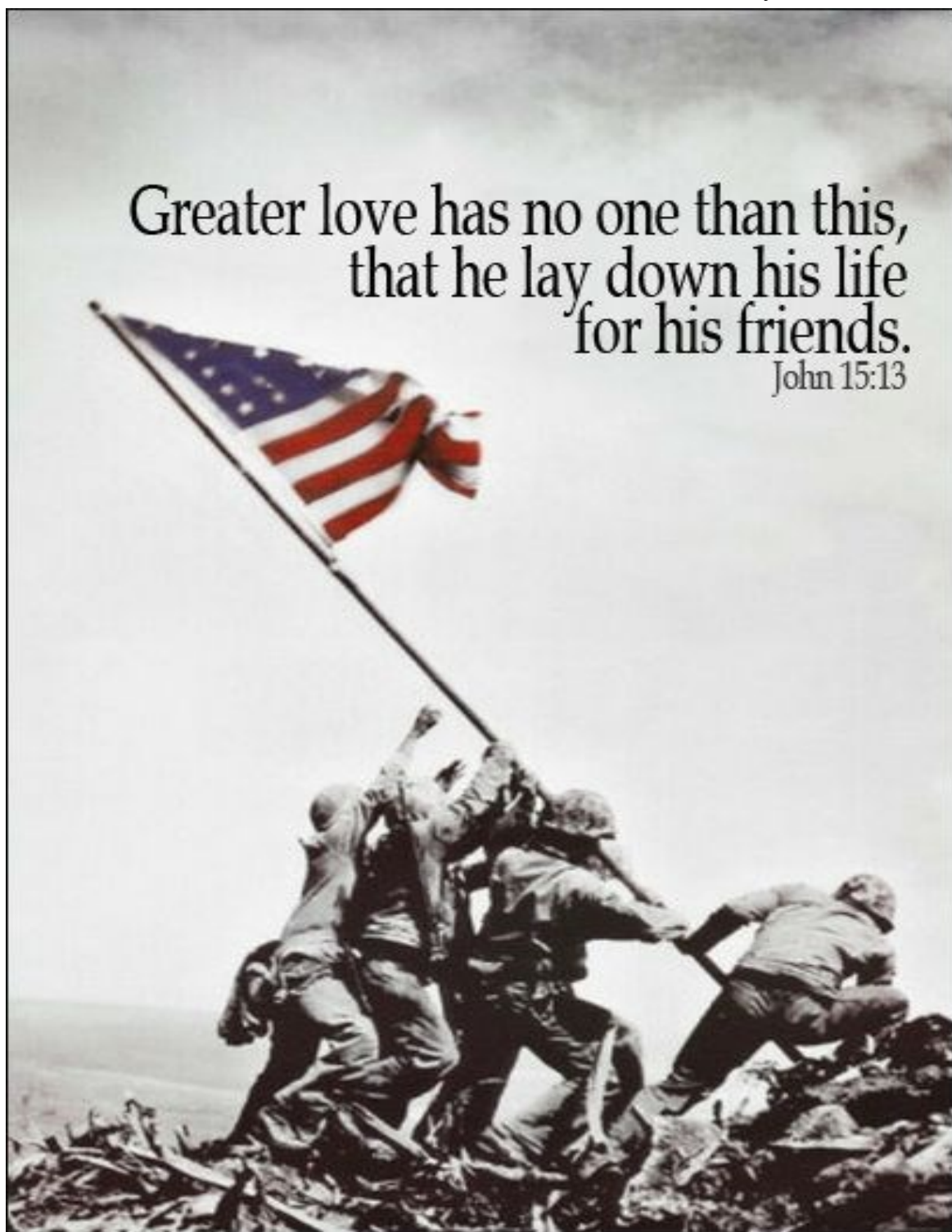

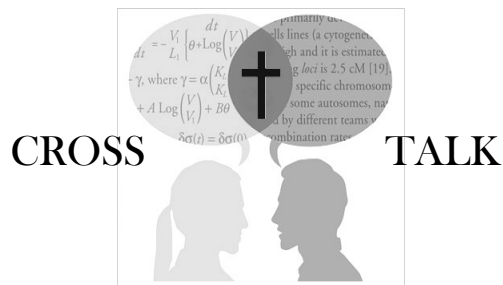

## Summer Quarter Bible Classes

The Lakeview Church of Christ is *A Work in Progress*. Much has been accomplished but there is still much to do. God's people throughout history have been challenged by this truth. But they did not all rise to meet the challenge. Our classes this summer are intended to equip each one of us for the work ahead.

### Beginning on Sunday, June 5<sup>th</sup>, we will have two new Textual Bible Classes on Sunday morning:

**Auditorium Class - Hosea: A Messy Marriage** - In this class, we will make our way through the book of Hosea. Hosea is one of the rare books written to the Northern Kingdom of Israel, before their destruction. In it, God is in anguish for His people, who have broken their covenant with Him. In this book, we will get a clearer picture of God's relationship with His people, and the anguish He experiences when His people leave His covenant. It's all played out between Israel and God, but it's absolutely relevant to the church today, because we are the bride of Christ. Ben Cook will be teaching this class.

**Room # 4 – Simple Faith: Insights From the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7)** – This class will present the basic building blocks of Christian faith. In this extended discourse, Jesus teaches His disciples what it means to be a citizen of the Kingdom of God, on earth. These principles result in strong individuals who are able to contribute to the building of a strong church. Dennis Baker & Kenny Coleman will be co-leading this study.

### Beginning on Wednesday, June 8<sup>th</sup> we will present our Wednesday Summer Series in the Auditorium:

**Hand Me Another Brick: A Study of Nehemiah** – When God's people have a project to complete, how we go about it is different from the dog-eat-dog mentality that characterizes the world of business. Nehemiah models a rare blend of godliness, tact, discipline, determination, grace and objectivity. You will marvel at his organizational skills and be inspired by his faith. Lessons will be presented by 11 gifted men from the congregation. We will also intersperse a few song-learning sessions during the summer quarter.

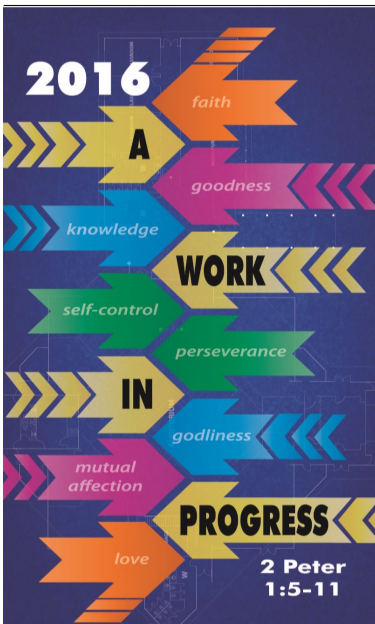

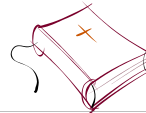
