



Always keep in contact with those books and those people that enlarge your horizon and make it possible for you to stretch yourself mentally. Oswald Chambers

This is solid advice for Christians who desire to avoid stagnation in their faith. Some find it challenging because they think that have come to a place of good standing in the church and the eyes of the Lord, and really don't need anything more. Even Paul would not claim this for himself. Some find it difficult because they are afraid to ask for help. They wrongly think that asking reflects weakness in spiritual zeal. It actually suggests the opposite. Asking demonstrates that we realize that there is more and we want all that God has intended.

If I lack wisdom about some circumstance, ask God for that wisdom (James 1:5). God's wisdom always changes the outcome of any situation. If you are feeling spiritually weak, ask for the Holy Spirit (Luke 11:13). God is like a good father who likes to give good gifts. The best gift the Father has given (after the grace of the cross) is the presence of the Holy Spirit.

For our Men's Ministry, we have chosen Proverbs 27:17 as our standard. This also suggests asking. It teaches us to take the initiative to engage in one another's lives, to ask the tough questions and receive the tough answers. This positive action, coupled with asking God for what we need from Him, creates men (and women) of faith who are able to stay on course as we tack toward our destination.

As we encounter the winds of culture, we have to decide if we are going to tack across it or be pushed by it. I will say it again, the solution is not to be pushed and directed by the winds of culture, but to resist it and keep adjusting to the variations so that we can harness the power that is created when you go against the wind.

Pray for the protection and success of the Men's Ministry. Pray that it will be used by God as a context for men seeking Him and a place where men of God can be honed by men of God. We hope you are planning to attend. We will be serving meat, both spiritually and physically.

those of the canary in 14 days; those of the barnyard hen in 21 days; eggs of ducks and geese in 28 days; those of the mallard in 35 days; The eggs of the parrot and the ostrich hatch in 42 days. (Notice, they are all divisible by seven, the number of days in a week!)

God's wisdom is seen in the making of an elephant. The four legs of this great beast all bend forward in the same direction. No other quadruped is so made. God planned that this animal would have a huge body, too large to live on two legs. For this reason He gave it four fulcrums so that it can rise from the ground easily.

*The horse rises from the ground on its two front legs first.
A cow rises from the ground with its two hind legs first.
How wise the Lord is in all His works of creation!*

Each watermelon has an even number of stripes on the rind. Each orange has an even number of segments. Each ear of corn has an even number of rows. Each stalk of wheat has an even number of grains. Every bunch of bananas has on its lowest row an even number of bananas, and each row decreases by one, so that one row has an even number and the next row an odd number. Amazing!

The waves of the sea roll in on shore twenty-six to the minute in all kinds of weather. All grains are found in even numbers on the stalks.

God has caused the flowers to blossom at certain specified times during the day.

Linnaeus, the great botanist, once said that if he had a conservatory containing the right kind of soil, moisture and temperature, he could tell the time of day or night by the flowers that were open and those that were closed!

The lives of each of us may be ordered by the Lord in a beautiful way for His glory, if we will only entrust Him with our life. If we try to regulate our own life, it will only be a mess and a failure. Only God, who made our brain and heart, can successfully guide them to a profitable end.


