

In many parts of the country, during the hazy, lazy days of summer, you can hear the loud, shrill sound of the male Cicada. I think they are trying to attract a mate, but I find the noise very annoying. Sometimes the noise will fill the air and then die down, only to rise to another crescendo, and then relative quiet. You usually see them in the trees, but that is not where they start out.

They start out living underground, some for a few years and some for up to 17 years. When the time comes for the Cicadas to emerge, they burrow to the surface and then climb the nearest tree, or house, or wherever they can attach, and begin the process of changing from a larva to an adult. At times while climbing trees, we would find the empty exoskeleton. They look like creatures from another world with their claws and legs clinging to the branch. But it isn't even alive. It is just an empty shell of the life form it used to be. If you put the slightest pressure on that empty form, it will crumble. That's what I think of when I hear the phrase "a form of godliness." It bears some resemblance to the real thing. But there's no life in it.

Before we leave the study of godliness, we should highlight what Paul says in 2 Timothy 3:1-5 concerning the "last days." He warns there will be people in the church who appear to be godly, but have none of the identifiers of godliness. In fact, what they look like is described in verses 2-4. They are lovers of self, and not lovers of God. They do not connect to the power of God. That is why their lives look more like the world rather than like Christ. He tells us that there will be difficult times in the body of Christ because of them. You can recognize them by the things mentioned in Verses 2-4. When you encounter this, seek to rebuke and correct with humility and love. If there is no repentance (change), he tells us to avoid these people.

The importance of this passage is not only that we should be aware of these type of folks, we should also strive to be Christians who have the substance of godliness.

This is the only life that will endure. When pressure comes, if you are only a shell, you will crumble. But if you have the substance of godliness, when pressure comes, you will stand


