A Single Gift - 1 Corinthians 7:32-35

Church can be a tough place to belong and even harder if you're single. We spend so much time focusing on the sanctity of marriage, the noble pursuits of fatherhood/motherhood, and the many, many, many, many different ministries that we have which are family-specific, that it can send a very clear message that God really only has a place for you if you fit into a nuclear family *package*.

Contrary to this, Paul challenges the church at Corinth to consider that being single releases men and women to serve in greater ways than their married counterparts. Being single is a gift. Embrace it!
