Matthew 22:15-22

¹⁵Then the Pharisees went and plotted how to trap Him by what He said.¹⁶They sent their disciples to Him, with the Herodians. “Teacher,” they said, “we know that You are truthful and teach truthfully the way of God. You defer to no one, for You don’t show partiality.¹⁷Tell us, therefore, what You think. Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar or not?”

¹⁸ But perceiving their malice, Jesus said, “Why are you testing Me, hypocrites? ¹⁹Show Me the coin used for the tax.” So they brought Him a denarius. ²⁰“Whose image and inscription is this?” He asked them.

²¹“Caesar’s,” they said to Him. Then He said to them, “Therefore give back to Caesar the things that are Caesar’s, and to God the things that are God’s.” ²²When they heard this, they were amazed. So they left Him and went away.



Hello Lakeview Family,

As we look forward to being able to worship together in the Lakeview building, it is imperative that we are reminded of our responsibility for each other with love. "This is my commandment, that you love each other as I have loved you." John 5:12; "Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interest of each other." Philippians 2:4; For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." Galatians 5:14

The Lakeview elders have been meeting weekly to provide worship resources to maintain classes and virtual worship services. We have met with our deacons, ministry leaders and life group leaders to gather input on how to reopen our church building, our face to face worship, and our meetings, responsibly. Based on the feedback received, we propose a phase-by-phase approach that helps us live out our scriptural calling, meet the needs of our members, and protect the health of those in the church and in the community.

As stay-at-home restrictions are loosened, gathering in small numbers, and meeting outside, will be encouraged first. Therefore, life group gatherings are the first activity to be implemented.

Our plan, as referenced above is to begin by having an outside worship service on June 7th, 2020 and begin life group gatherings for those groups that are ready.

We are excited about this, as life group gatherings are a wonderful way to live out God's call for us. These groups can reach out to many who are not ready to enter a church building but would accept an invitation to a group. They can also help prepare for the start of in-person worship services by gathering each week for worship and then joining with other life groups to attend in-person worship when it resumes. Building strong life groups gives us a solid and flexible foundation for eventual church ministry in which we all meet together.
