As we look forward to being able to worship together in the Lakeview building, it is imperative that we are reminded of our responsibility for each other with love. The Lakeview elders have been meeting weekly to provide worship resources to maintain classes and virtual worship services. Based on the feedback received, we propose a phase-by-phase approach that helps us live out our scriptural calling, meet the needs of our members, and protect the health of those in the church and in the community.

As stay-at-home restrictions are loosened, gathering in small numbers, and meeting outside, will be encouraged first. Therefore, life group gatherings are the first activity to be implemented.

We are excited about this, as life group gatherings are a wonderful way to live out God's call for us. These groups can reach out to many who are not ready to enter a church building but would accept an invitation to a group. They can also help prepare for the start of in-person worship services by gathering each week for worship and then joining with other life groups to attend in-person worship when it resumes. Building strong life groups gives us a solid and flexible foundation for eventual church ministry in which we all meet together.
