



## I'm All Wrapped Up, All Tied Up, All Tangled Up In Jesus



- John 8:1-11, <sup>1</sup>But Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. <sup>2</sup>At dawn He went to the temple complex again, and all the people were coming to Him. He sat down and began to teach them.

<sup>3</sup>Then the scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman caught in adultery, making her stand in the center. <sup>4</sup>“Teacher,” they said to Him, “this woman was caught in the act of committing adultery. <sup>5</sup>In the law Moses commanded us to stone such women. So what do You say?”

<sup>6</sup>They asked this to trap Him, in order that they might have evidence to accuse Him. Jesus stooped down and started writing on the ground with His finger. <sup>7</sup>When they persisted in questioning Him, He stood up and said to them, “The one without sin among you should be the first to throw a stone at her.”

<sup>8</sup>Then He stooped down again and continued writing on the ground. <sup>9</sup>When they heard this, they left one by one, starting with the older men. Only He was left, with the woman in the center. <sup>10</sup>When Jesus stood up, He said to her, “Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?”

<sup>11</sup>“No one, Lord,” she answered.

“Neither do I condemn you,” said Jesus. “Go, and from now on do not sin anymore.”
