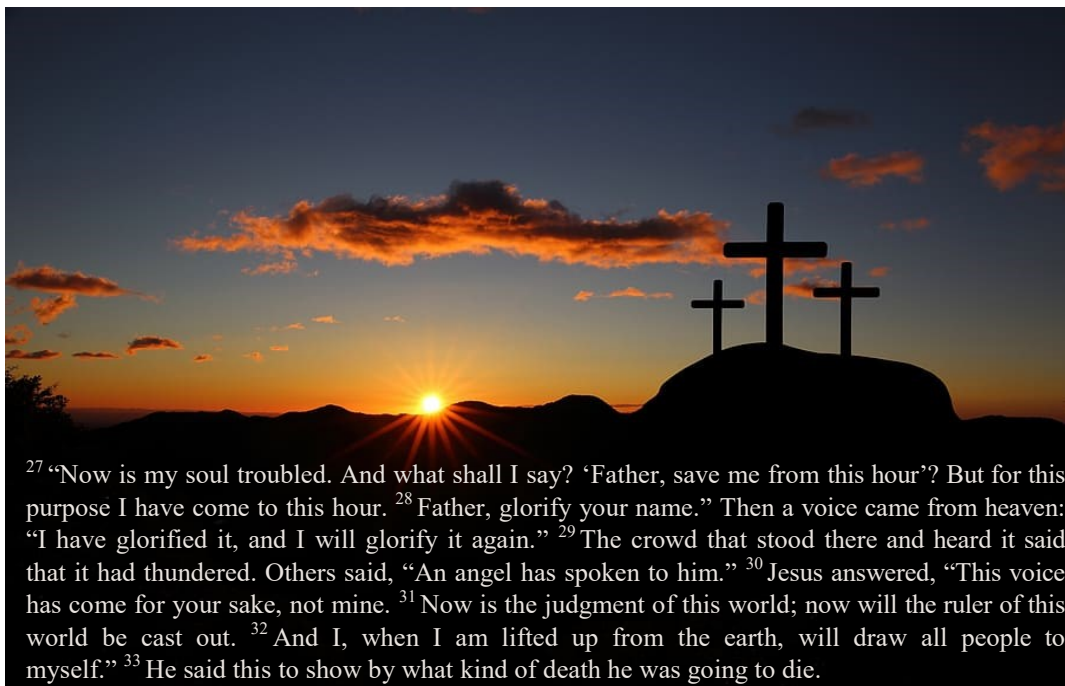


Oh How I Love Jesus

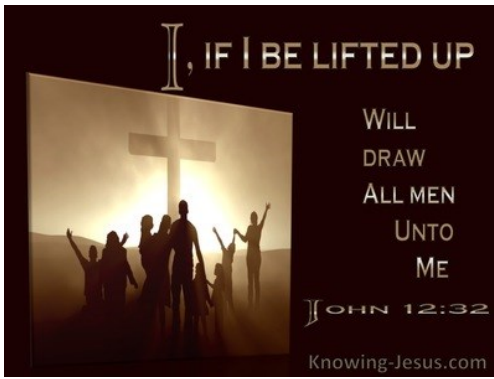
