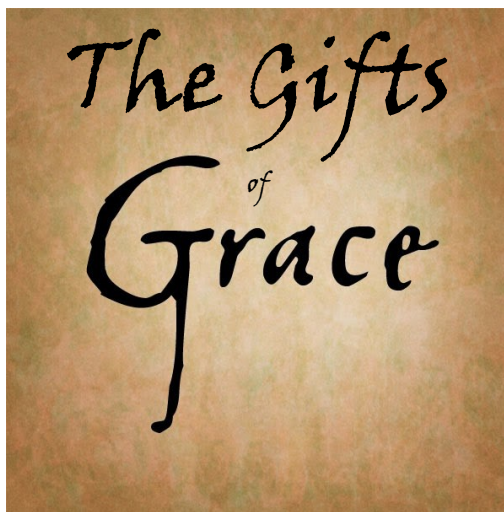

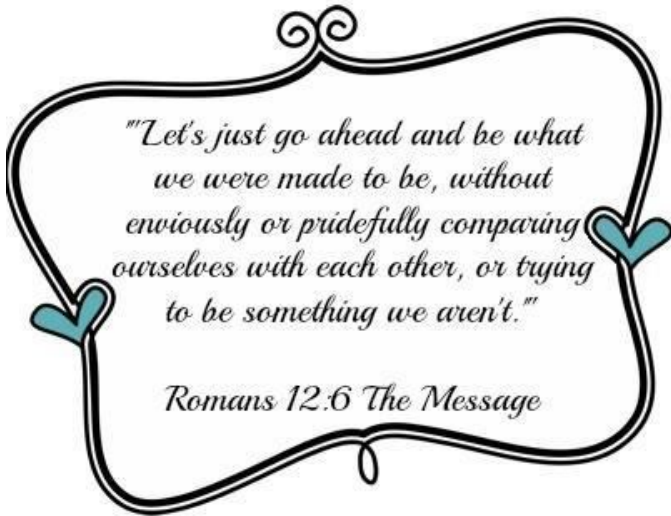


FAMILY NEWS
