## BURNT OFFERING - PART I

LEVITICUS 1:1-17; GENESIS 22:1-2,5-14

Leviticus 1 Then the LORD called to Moses and spoke to him from the Meeting Tent: <sup>2</sup> "Speak to the Israelites and tell them, 'When someone among you presents an offering to the LORD, you must present your offering from the domesticated animals, either from the herd or from the flock.<sup>3</sup> If his offering is a burnt offering from the herd he must present it as a flawless male; he must present it at the entrance of the Meeting Tent for its acceptance before the LORD. <sup>4</sup> He must lay his hand on the head of the burnt offering, and it will be accepted for him to make atonement on his behalf. <sup>5</sup> Then the one presenting the offering must slaughter the bull before the LORD, and the sons of Aaron, the priests, must present the blood and splash the blood against the sides of the altar, which is at the entrance of the Meeting Tent. <sup>6</sup> Next, the one presenting the



offering must skin the burnt offering and cut it into parts, <sup>7</sup> and the sons of Aaron, the priest, must put fire on the altar and arrange wood on the fire. <sup>8</sup> Then the sons of Aaron, the priests, must arrange the parts with the head and the suet on the wood that is in the fire on the altar. <sup>9</sup> Finally, the one presenting the offering must wash its entrails and its legs in water and the priest must offer all of it up in smoke on the altar - it is a burnt offering, a gift of a soothing aroma to the Lord. <sup>10</sup> If his offering is from the flock for a burnt offering - from the sheep or the goats - he must present a flawless male, <sup>11</sup> and must slaughter it on the north side of the altar before the Lord, and the sons of Aaron, the priests, will splash its blood against the altar's sides. <sup>12</sup> Next, the one presenting the offering must cut it into parts, with its head and its suet, and the priest must arrange them on the wood that is in the fire on the altar. <sup>13</sup> Then the one presenting the offering must wash the entrails and the legs in water, and the priest must present all of it and offer it up in smoke on the altar - it is a burnt offering, a gift of a soothing aroma to the Lord. <sup>14</sup> If his offering to the Lord is a burnt offering of birds, he must present his offering from the turtledoves or from the young pigeons. <sup>15</sup> The priest must present it at the altar, pinch off its head and offer the head up in smoke on the altar, and its blood must be drained out against the side of the altar. <sup>16</sup> Then the priest must remove its entrails by cutting off its tail feathers, and throw them to the east side of the altar into the place of fatty ashes, <sup>17</sup> and tear it open by its wings without dividing it into two parts. Finally, the priest must offer it up in smoke on the altar on the wood which is in the fire - it is a burnt offering, a gift of a soothing aroma to the Lord.

Genesis 22 <sup>1</sup>Some time after these things God tested Abraham. He said to him, "Abraham!" "Here I am!" Abraham replied. <sup>2</sup>God said, "Take your son - your only son, whom you love, Isaac - and go to the land of Moriah! Offer him up there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains which I will indicate to you." ... <sup>5</sup>So he said to his servants, "You two stay here with the donkey while the boy and I go up there. We will worship and then return to you." <sup>6</sup> Abraham took the wood for the burnt offering and put it on his son Isaac. Then he took the fire and the knife in his hand, and the two of them walked on together. <sup>7</sup> Isaac said to his father Abraham, "My father?" "What is it, my son?" he replied. "Here is the fire and the wood," Isaac said, "but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?" 8"God will provide for himself the lamb for the burnt offering, my son," Abraham replied. The two of them continued on together. 9 When they came to the place God had told him about, Abraham built the altar there and arranged the wood on it. Next he tied up his son Isaac and placed him on the altar on top of the wood. <sup>10</sup> Then Abraham reached out his hand, took the knife, and prepared to slaughter his son. <sup>11</sup> But the angel of the LORD called to him from heaven, "Abraham! Abraham!" "Here I am!" he answered. <sup>12</sup> "Do not harm the boy!" the angel said. "Do not do anything to him, for now I know that you fear God because you did not withhold your son, your only son, from me." 13 Abraham looked up and saw behind him a ram caught in the bushes by its horns. So he went over and got the ram and offered it up as a burnt offering instead of his son. 14 And Abraham called the name of that place "The LORD provides." It is said to this day, "In the mountain of the LORD provision will be made."
