The last few months have been a whirlwind. Classwork and events have proved to take most of our free time, but God has proven Himself to be good and faithful through it all. We will finally be able to restart sending monthly newsletters. Thank you for your patience and prayers.

Sunset has been and continues to be fantastic. This term allowed for more practical classes that focused on Christian Counseling and Leadership development within the church. One of Tristen's passions is to work with the next generation of the church and to develop leaders amongst them. He also studied Old Testament preaching, the book of Jeremiah and contemporary writing. All the classes continue to sharpen and prepare him for a life of ministry. Thank you for being a part of that goal.

Starting in October, Kaylee has begun attending Covenant School of Nursing. She is currently studying to achieve her RN license. We are looking forward to seeing the opportunities that God will provide through the nursing program. This is a two-year course, so we are set to graduate in the same year, 2025.

With the new year began a new term for the AIMers. They are now reorganized to work in the teams that they will be going to the field with. We have the pleasure of working with the team going to Leicester, England. As AIM assistants, it is our role to mentor these AIM students as they prepare for the field and coach them on conflict resolution and team dynamics. We also take them to work with an area church each Sunday they are in town. We have had the privilege to serve Denver City Church of Christ with the team, and we have been very impressed by them. Please keep these AIMers in your prayer as they finish their training in Lubbock.

We continue to drive to Pecos, TX once a month in order for Tristen to teach Bible classes and preach for the morning and evening services. It is a blessing that allows him to hone his skills as a speaker. The Sunset

Youth Group also asked him to speak on a Wednesday night and teach on the subject, *Living Out Your Faith*. He had attended this youth group himself while in High School, so this was a major blessing to be able to give back.

Speaking of opportunities to present the Word, Tristen was asked to represent the school during the Sunset Vision Workshop and to speak as the student keynote speaker. He presented on the *Power of the Gospel*, using Romans 1:16 as his passage. His lesson focused on empowering believers to stand unashamed of the gospel message, because it is truly the power of God alive in us and not our own abilities.

At the same time as the Workshop, AIM hosted it's weekend Camp Adventure for teens interested in possibly attending the AIM program in the future. This camp, as well as the week-long one that will be hosted in March, is an incredible opportunity to promote AIM and encourage the next generation to consider what they can do to fulfill the call to go into all the world and share the gospel. We helped run logistics for the camp, Tristen worked as point man for a day and Kaylee helped prepare meals for the campers and AIMers.

Since AIM is building new housing for future AIM classes, they will be ending their leases with the apartments they currently reserve for AIMers. We had been blessed to rent those same apartments from AIM, so we needed to find a new place to live. In December we were able to move into a new rental house that is close enough to Sunset that Tristen is able to walk to school! What a blessing!
