Dear Friends,

At Mountain States Children's Home, we are committed to providing a nurturing environment for children in need. We strive to provide a *Deeper Level of Care* addressing the emotional, educational, spiritual, and physical needs of our residents, based on Luke 2:52.

Our focus today is on the physical well-being of the children in our care, specifically the essential needs of our residents. At MSCH, to provide the "bare necessities" for a cottage of 8-10 people, the cost is approximately \$11,500. These necessities include:

**Nutritious Meals:** Ensuring that every child receives three balanced meals a day, providing the nourishment necessary for their physical growth and well-being.

**Safe Living Conditions:** Providing each child with a safe and comfortable living space, complete with qualified house parents, clothing, utilities, personal care items, etc.

This does not include their private school education, professional counseling, or medical/vision/dental care, which is all part of our *Deeper Level of Care*.

The impact of your generous donation extends beyond meeting immediate needs; it creates a foundation for these children to build upon, fostering their physical health and contributing to their overall development.
