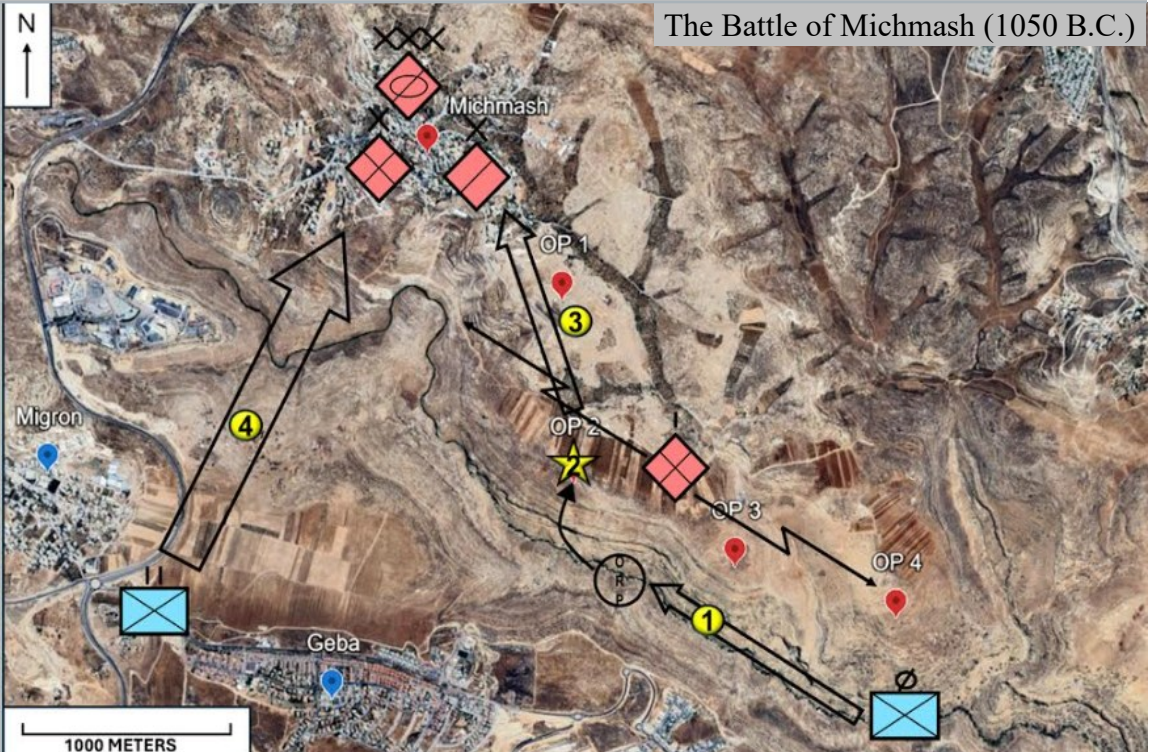


① Jonathan maneuvers through the pass (1 Sam. 14:4)

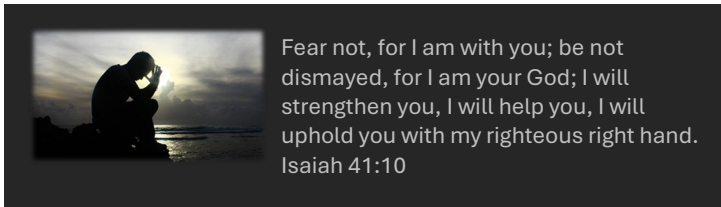
