

Hello brethren, family, and friends,

Rose and I are always grateful to be able to share with you all the blessing of serving Him in the French world for all these years, all because God entrusted His great commission to His Church. We are delighted to be His ambassadors like our brother Paul tell us in 2 Corinthians 5:18-20, "That God gave to us the ministry of reconciliation and we are therefore ambassador on behalf of Christ" and in Ephesians 2:10, "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." Rose and I desire to continue to do His good work to spread the gospel of Christ.

Regarding this work we have good news to share with you all once again. In case you have forgotten, the French-speaking world represents 630 million people around the world, but the laborers are few, especially in the French world. The Bible tells us that there are still people all over the world searching and seeking God (Acts 17:21-27). God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from any one of us.

In regard to brother Matthis Mwengem I am staying in contact with him, and he continues to go to the Lord's church in Verviers every Lord's Day. He told about his friend in Paris, Désiré, who is 18 years old, and she had been going to the ICC. But when she requested to be baptized by them, they refused to do so and told her that she was not faithful enough to participate in all the Bible studies they have every week (5 per week). Matthis told her to quit going there and to join us, and that I was willing to study with her. I sent to Matthis many videos about the ICC movement and documents that he could send her, which he did. She has decided to contact me and we should see the outcome.

Halison Andrianaivoarivelo, a young 21-year-old man from Madagascar, got in contact with me through brother Chad Breaux from Texas. After I wrote to him, the very next day he replied. Since that time I study with him every day, and some days even 3 times a day. In Madagascar he attended with his mom the Universal Church, started by a Brazilian pastor. Once he moved to Paris for his studies in computer engineering, he was contacted by another Pentecostal group; he been going there for about 6-9 months and it's in this group that he accepted Jesus in his heart, later on he was baptized by that group, but after studying the word with Chad and me, he realizes that his baptism was not in harmony with God's word. After studying with him 12 times, my last study with him was about the relationship of Jesus' Blood and salvation. That study made it clear for him that he was not in Christ and still in his sin. Asking him what he was planning to do about it he replied 'I will think about and let you know.' The next day we studied about the one foundation established only by Christ and not man. We are presently studying about the Kingdom and Reign of God. I must say that Halison followed our worship twice by Zoom and the third time was with us at sister Françoise's place for worship.

Antoine Tran Thanh contact of sister Colette Chao came to sister Francoise's 3 weeks ago. He was so pleased with our worship that he says that he will come every time we meet! I offered him a BCC and a Bible since he did not own one. In one weeks', time he finished 3 lessons and did well on them. Last Sunday we met at sister Francoise's place. I gave him the last lessons of the course which contains 11 lessons altogether.

I am continuing to help Brother Simon in Cameroon, sending him sermons and Bible material. Likewise I am also helping the church in Guinea Conakry, where brother Beavogui Zeze the evangelist of the congregation there. Regarding Christian Dupros after taking a series of chemotherapy now he starts radiation for six weeks. We are all praying that according to God's will that he will be healed. We are continuing to pray for Brother Paul Durizot and his family. Sister Chiméne announces to the church that she will have a 3rd child, a little girl this coming month. We are praying that everything will go well for her and the future baby.

Our attendance went up the last two Sundays 28 and the last one 32. We have been looking for a place for the church to meet for some time, and thank God we find one but prices in Paris are not cheap to rent and we can have it only Sunday morning from 9 AM till 12:30.

From April 9th till 14th, we will have the visit of Brother Tim president of Sunset International Bible Institute and one of the elders of the congregation there. Rose and I will be flying to the States April 14th till October 26th and while there we will be visiting families and friends, preaching and teaching just like I did last year, but there are also other brethren here that will help with the teaching and preaching while we are gone. Serving at the local congregation we attend, but also visiting the contacts I made last year. I will continue to preach and teach the Church in Paris by Zoom while we visit the U.S. Rose and I we will be going to Canada to participate to the annual retreat of the French congregations. Like every year I will be teaching and preaching but this year I will not be cooking, a sister there volunteered to cook with the help of other sisters.

Financially we have lost another \$200.00 per month which makes a total of \$750.00 per month for 2025. The French government has decided to impose another additional tax on all airfares. Rose and I are indeed grateful to all of you who have and are continuing to support us spiritually and financially.
